


Divorce Clinic



inTouch can help you apply for a divorce in Australia. To do this, we need you to complete this checklist before coming to the clinic.

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- ☐ You have been separated for more than 12 months and 1 day and
- ☐ There is no chance that you will reconcile with your spouse
-  If you are still living together in the same house, please let us know.

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Documents you **must** bring to the Divorce Clinic:

- ☐ Please bring your Marriage Certificate, and if it is not in English, you will need it to be translated by a certified translator.
-  If you do not have your Marriage Certificate translated, please speak to us before coming to the Divorce Clinic.
-  If you do not have a Marriage Certificate at all, please speak to us before coming to the Divorce Clinic.
- ☐ An Australian Citizenship Certificate, Australian passport or Letter of Visa grant from the Department of Home Affairs
- ☐ Any Family Violence Intervention Orders
- ☐ Any current Court orders or parenting plans relating to children
- ☐ Counselling certificate if you have been married for less than 2 years

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- ☐ **If you have a computer:**
Bring it with you to the Divorce Clinic
- ☐ **If you don't have a computer:**
Let us know and we'll try to organise one for you
- ☐ **Bring a credit or debit card to pay the Divorce Filing Fee**
The usual fee is **\$990** or the reduced fee is **\$330**

If you want to apply for the reduced fee, please bring the following documents:

— Health care card, Pensioner Concession Card, Commonwealth Seniors Health Card or any other card issued by the Department Human Services or the Department of Veterans' Affairs that certifies your entitlement to Commonwealth health concessions

or

— Evidence that you are receiving Youth Allowance, Austudy or ABSTUDY payments
